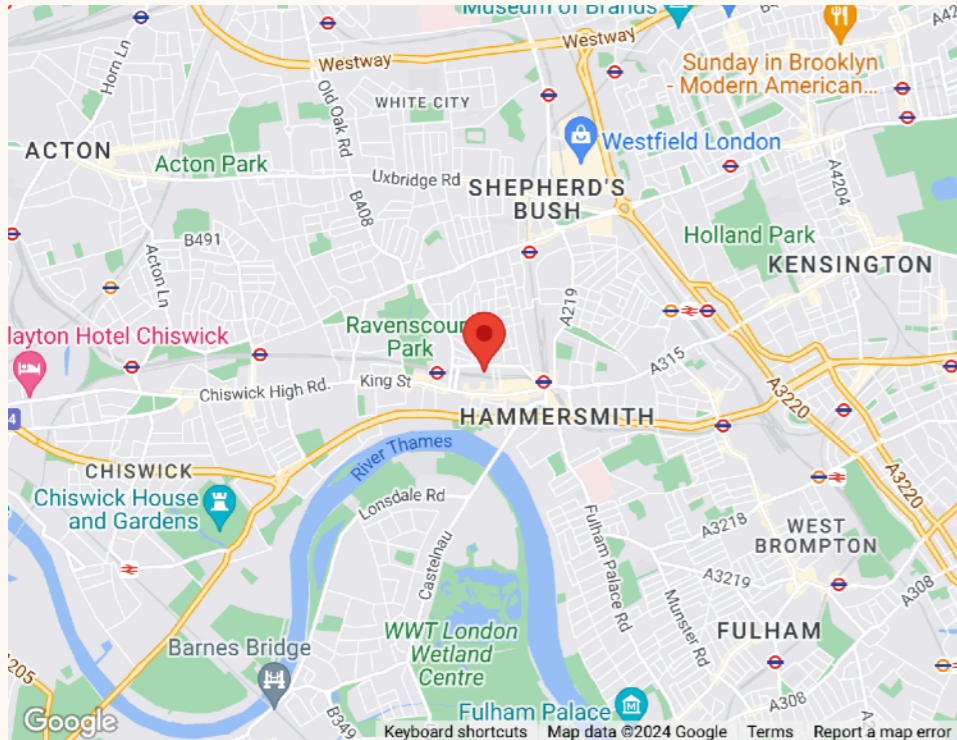

COURSES IN HAMMERSMITH - THE ARCH



ONE WEEK COURSE

MONDAY TO FRIDAY: 10:30-13:00 HRS.

During the one week course you can work on self directed projects over five consecutive days. Projects include hand building on Monday, coiling/slab-built forms to make a series of pots, plates and sculptural forms in clay. Learn how to centre clay & throw cylinder shapes on the pottery wheel on Tuesday. Refine thrown forms and continue to develop hand built sculptures and pots on Wednesday/Thursday and decorate with coloured slips on Friday. The glazing is two weeks afterwards.



HAND-BUILDING AND THROWING / FOUR WEEKS COURSE

MONDAY: 10:30-13:00 HRS

WEDNESDAY: 18:30-21:00 HRS

During this course you will learn how to centre the clay on a pottery wheel and make a cup/bowl shape. Learn hand building techniques: pinching, coiling, slab building and pressing clay into plaster moulds.

Projects are self directed and you can learn how to make plates, vessels or sculptures. You will also learn how to apply a glaze to your fired work in the fourth week. The course is inclusive of all materials and firing costs.



THROWING / FOUR WEEKS COURSE

TUESDAY: 10:30-13:00 HRS OR 18:30-21:00 HRS

SUNDAY: 14:00-16:30 HRS

During this course you will learn how to centre clay and throw a series of cylinder shapes on the pottery wheel. During three 2.5hr sessions you will practice throwing techniques. On last week, you will learn how to apply a glaze to a selection of work. The cost is Inclusive of materials and firings.



HAND-BUILDING, THROWING AND DECORATING TECHNIQUES / SIX WEEKS COURSE

THURSDAYS: 18:00-21:00 HRS

This course will cover hand building: Slab work, Throwing and a broad range of surface decorating techniques when working in ceramics. Ideal for artists and makers to discover new decorating techniques or to expand their technical knowledge in clay. The course will include slip and engobe, inlay application alongside monotype transfer printing methods. We will also cover decorative and practical approaches to using glaze on bisqueware.



THROWING LEVEL 2 / EIGHTS WEEKS COURSE

SATURDAYS: 14:00-17:00 HRS

In this course we will learn how to make closed forms (boxes/jugs with lids) and learn how to construct a water jug from three thrown pieces/elements. throwing pieces for a water jug. You will learn throwing closed forms, trimming and glazing. Learn how to design and plan forms/Weighing/Measuring/Preparing clay.

You must be able to centre and competently throw cylinders and bowls already.

All materials are provided and included.



HAND-BUILDING AND THROWING / EIGHTS WEEKS COURSE

MONDAYS: 10:30-13:00 HRS

During this course you will learn how to centre the clay on a pottery wheel, throw a cylinder shape, turn a foot on the base of your pot. THROWING / EIGHTS WEEKS COURSE

TUESDAYS: 10:30-13:00 HRS OR 18:30-21:00 HRS

During this course you will learn how to centre clay and throw a series of cylinder shapes on the pottery wheel. Continue practicing throwing techniques. Refine your shapes using turning tools and learn how to apply a glaze to a selection of work. The cost is inclusive of materials and firings.

COURSES IN BARNES - THE BARN



HAND-BUILDING AND THROWING LEVEL 1 & 2 / FOUR WEEKS COURSE

MONDAYS: 10:30-13:00 HRS

THURSDAYS: 10:30-13:00 HRS OR 18:00-20:30 HRS

This is a four week course on Monday mornings with a maximum group size of six students. During this course you will learn hand building techniques: pinching, coiling, slab building for two sessions and throwing on the pottery wheel for one session. Learn how to make plates, vessels or sculptures. On the fourth session learn how to apply a glaze to a selection of your best work. Inclusive of all materials and firing costs.



THROWING LEVEL / FOUR WEEKS COURSE

TUESDAYS: 10:30-13:00 HRS OR 18:00-20:30 HRS

SATURDAYS: 14:00-16:30 HRS

This is a four week course for beginners with a maximum of six students. During this course you will learn how to centre the clay and throw a series of cylinder shapes on the pottery wheel in weeks 1 & 2. Refine shapes with turning tools and techniques in week 3, learn how to apply a glaze to a selection your best fired work in week 4.



HAND-BUILDING AND THROWING LEVEL 1 & 2 / EIGHT WEEKS COURSE

THURSDAYS: 10:30-13:00 HRS

During this course you will learn how to centre the clay on a pottery wheel, throw a cylinder shape, turn a foot on the base of your pot. Learn hand building techniques: pinching, coiling, slab building and pressing clay into plaster moulds. Projects are self directed and you can learn how to make plates, vessels or sculptures. You will also learn how to apply a glaze to your work (mid way) and at the end of the course.



THROWING LEVEL 2 / EIGHT WEEKS COURSE

WEDNESDAYS: 10:00-13:00 HRS

This is an intermediate level course. You will learn how to make closed forms (boxes/jugs with lids) and learn how to construct a water jug from three thrown pieces/elements. You will learn to throw pieces for a water jug, closed forms, trimming and glazing. Learn how to design and plan forms/Weighing/Measuring/Preparing clay. You must be able to centre and competently throw cylinders and bowls already.
